#### **PROSPECTUS**

St. Stanislaus' College is a Christian institution that has been conducted for over one hundred years by a Staff that includes members of the Society of Jesus. It aims at imparting both intellectual and technical skills and at forming citizens of Guyana who are imbued with a reverence for God, a love of their religion and a spirit of service to their country. It offers an education that stresses academic excellence and respect for manual labour, and is at the same time based on a philosophy of co-operation, a spirit of sharing and working together for the good of all.

The normal five years' course of studies leads to the G.C.E. London) at Ordinary Level. There is a further two years' course for the G.C.E. Advanced Level London).

The College has five good Science Laboratories and there is a full course in Physics, Chemistry and Biology for every boy. There is a College Library, and the College is equipped with audio-visual aids. An Art room, a Modern Languages room, and a Geography room have been set up, and Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics and Economics are taught to Advanced Level. Agricultural Science and Industrial Arts have been introduced into the curriculum with the setting up of a School Farm and Workshop.

On our playing field near the Sea Wall, we are able to provide full facilities for cricket, football and athletics under the supervision of the College Staff and experienced Coaches. Volley-ball, table-tennis, badminton, basket-ball, swimming, judo and scouting are also offered.

The school year consists of three terms. Classes begin at 7.40 a.m. and end at 1.30 p.m. with a Canteen lunch provided at 10.50 a.m. Forms 1, 2, 3) and 11 30 a.m. Forms 4, 5, 6).

FEES, not including books, \$46.00 per term. Extras for games, \$3.00 per term. SPECIAL FEES for brothers: \$76.00 per term tor two brothers in the school at the same time.

ADMISSION: Admission to Form 1 is normally through the Common Entrance Examination. A few boys over 12 and under 13 years on March 31 are admitted on the results of the College Entrance Examination held early in April. All those who wish to gain admission to the College, should obtain an Entrance Form during March.
