Dr. Chairman,

I have the honour in presenting to this gathering of stakeholders, the Principal's Report for the academic year, September 2023 to July 2024. This report seeks to enlighten us on our **Achievements**. It also highlights some **Challenges** and **Projections** for the future.

The report has been divided into seven key areas namely;

STUDENT ENROLMENT

The academic year began in September, 2023 with a total student population of **six hundred and five (605) students**. There were **two hundred and sixty-three (263) males and three hundred and forty-two (342) females**. The average number of students per class was thirty (30).

For the period under review, the admission of students to the college was based on the placement of students by the Ministry of Education.

- One hundred and eleven students from the National Grade Six Assessment (NGSA) comprising **forty-seven (47) males and sixty-four (64) females** were admitted to Grade Seven.
- Based on CXC-CSEC, 2023 results, **fifty-one (51) students** were admitted to Grade 12 to pursue CAPE. There were **twelve (12) males and thirty-nine (39) females**.

THE CURRICULUM

Honourable Chairman,

St. Stanislaus College continued to offer a broad-based curriculum to the students through Eleven Departments, namely:

- 1) Agricultural Science
- 2) Allied Arts
- 3) Business Education
- 4) English
- 5) Home Economics
- 6) Industrial Technology
- 7) Information Technology
- 8) Mathematics
- 9) Modern Languages
- 10) Science

11) Social Studies

At **Grades Seven and Eight**, all the subjects taught were compulsory.

At **Grade Ten**, students were allocated to one of the four streams at the college, depending on their ability, aptitude and career interest.

The total number of students who opted for the streams were as follows:

- 1) Arts Stream- **Seven (7)** students
- 2) Business Stream- **Thirty-three (33)** students
- 3) Science Stream- **Thirty-eight (38)** students
- 4) Technical Stream – **Eleven (11)** students

Students pursued a maximum of **ten (10)** subjects in each stream. English Language, English Literature and Mathematics, and one foreign language were compulsory across all Streams.

At **Grade Eleven**, all students wrote the Caribbean Examinations Council (CXC)- Caribbean Education Certificate Examinations (CSEC). A maximum of fifteen (16) subjects were written.

For **Grade Twelve**, students who gained at least Five (5) CSEC subjects including English A and Mathematics, with Grades I to III were offered a place to pursue studies for the Caribbean Advanced Proficiency Examination. Fifty-one (**51**) students were admitted for this programme and placed into one of three streams: Natural Sciences, Environmental Studies or Business.

EXTERNAL EXAMINATIONS RESULTS, 2024

Caribbean Secondary Education Certificate (CSEC) Results

Esteemed Chairman and Audience,

The academic performance of our students at the CXC-CSEC 2024 was excellent.

A brief analysis of the results revealed that:

- Students wrote **twenty-eight (28)** subjects at this examination. The overall percent passes gained for Grades One to Three was **92%**.
- Out of the **one hundred and ten (110)** Grade Eleven students who wrote the CSEC examination **One Hundred percent (100%)** of them matriculated. This means that all of our students got Grades One to Three in at least five subjects, including English A and Mathematics.

- There were **three hundred and fifty-one (351)** Grade Ones, **four hundred and forty-one (441)** Grade Twos and **two hundred and forty (240)** Grade Threes.
